Research practice (further in the text-RP)

(for graduate students who studied Scientometry in the 1st semester)

In order to successfully complete the RP, the graduate student is invited to familiarize himself with the Regulations on the postgraduate's RP:

The period of the RP is -2 weeks (108 hours, 3 ECTS).

The supervisor of the RP (the scientific supervisor of the graduate student) conducts 2 (two) consultations with the graduate student during which they are discussed and approved:

1. The PLAN-practice schedule; 2. The content of the practice.

After completing the RP, the graduate student defends the REPORT of the RP at a meeting of the department.

The REVIEW of the RS is prepared by the supervisor, the REVIEW is signed by the supervisor and approved by the head of the department.

In the spring attestation, the graduate student uploads to the Moodle system a package of accounting documents for RP: the PLAN, REPORT and REVIEW.

Scientific and pedagogical practice (further in the text-PP) (for graduate students who studied Higher school pedagogy in the 1st semester):

The period of the PP is -2 weeks (108 hours, 3 ECTS).

The supervisor of the PP (the scientific supervisor of the graduate student) conducts 1 (one) consultation with the graduate student during which they are discussed and approved:

The PLAN-practice schedule; 2. The content of the practice.

The graduate student submits the PLAN of the PP at a meeting of the department for discussion and approval, after which he proceeds to implement the activities of the plan approved by the department;

after completing the PP, the graduate student defends the REPORT of the PP at a meeting of the department;

the scientific supervisor prepares the REVIEW of the PP. The REVIEW is signed by the supervisor and approved by the head of the department.

In the spring attestation, the graduate student uploads to the Moodle system a package of accounting documents for RP: the PLA REPORT and REVIEW

A graduate student does not have the right to lecture (section 6, paragraph 6.2)

A graduate student working at the department under an employment contract, teaching activities can be credited/

ABOUT THE EVENTS IN THE SEMESTER



Research activities and preparation of scientific qualification work (dissertation):

- Research activities in the spring semester is 23 ECTS, 828 hours, that is, the graduate student is engaged in research activities weekly throughout the spring semester, as well as independently from June 17 to July 20;

-the supervisor advises the graduate student during the semester (see the schedule);

-from May 13 to May 31, the graduate student reports at a meeting of the department on the work done according to the individual plan of the graduate student for the ENTIRE ACADEMIC YEAR (final annual attestation).
